Thank you all so much for inviting me to be a part of your design project for Semester 1 2014. The opportunity for me as a small business owner to work with the students in designing a new logo was an exciting and fantastic experience.

I began the process with the belief that it would be an interesting journey that may give me some guidance in future planning for new styling of my business logo and stationery. What I got was a whole lot more than that.

To begin with, my involvement centred around the students endeavouring to identify the brief, that is – define what I wanted in a logo. It was an interesting experience for me, as some of the students asked questions of me that really encouraged me to think about things like demographic, colour choices and overall visual appeal, things that I may not necessarily have thought about previously. The students demonstrated a more professional approach than I expected, and some of their questions showed maturity and genuine interest.

As we progressed, the students reached the point where they were ready to present their initial sketches and ideas to me. This was a thoroughly enjoyable experience. After all, it is not easy to get up and speak in front of the class, judged for your work and marked for your efforts. I was impressed once again, by the maturity that the class showed. Some of the students were obviously more nervous than others, but I think it is a credit to you all the way that you undertook the challenge.

I'm pleased to say, it wasn't an easy job to select the winning logo. It was tough. Even now, looking through all of the final designs – I find myself attracted to different selections than the ones I initially chose.
