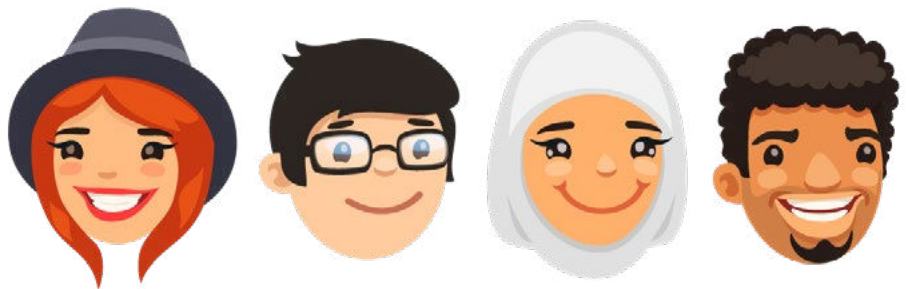

We visited the Bunbury Volunteer Bushfire Brigade where the volunteers gave us an introduction into fire biology and behaviour. We then got to kit up in PPE and learnt how to suppress fires using a fire extinguisher and a fire blanket.

We have also visited The Cut and Eaton Foreshore as part of our Storm Chasers Program to clean up rubbish and look for wildlife in distress. An ECU Southwest / Manea collab.
