Academic Scholarships are provided to Year 12 students based on an application process that involves the use of Year 11 achievement as the basis of decision making.

Scholarships are designed to cover College course costs, VET course costs, course materials, resources and uniform up to an agreed value.

Scholarships are open to students, irrespective of their chosen courses or pathways.

**Recipients will receive up to \$1000 and have College fees waived.**

## Equity Scholarships \$500 each

These scholarships recognise the barriers to education that affect some groups of students and are designed to assist with the costs associated with senior secondary studies.

Scholarships are provided to students from designated equity groups and are non-competitive in nature. Selection will be based on demonstrated need and personal circumstances.

Eligibility categories:

- Students with carer responsibilities
- Students who have a registered disability/ongoing medical condition/illness.
- Students who are independent minors.
- Students who are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.
- Students from non-English speaking backgrounds.

**Recipients will receive up to \$500 and have College fees waived.**

## Student Grant Donations \$200+

The aim of the Student Grants is to create a 'bucket' of money to distribute to students. A 'bucket' that provides financial support enabling students to access qualifications, courses, licences, training and other opportunities (outside of College courses).

This funding is intended to further enhance the employability of students and enable them to develop their skills, attitudes and knowledge, equipping them to be active members of the community.

Submissions are reviewed by the College staff in conjunction with the College Board to determine successful applicants.

### Examples of Grant Applications:

- Skill-based courses such as first aid, Auslan, Barista, finances, etc.
- Personal development courses such as leadership, public speaking, time management, etc.
- Lessons to gain a driver's license to enable access to work or education.

## Graduation Ceremony \$100
