### **SCHEDULE OF CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES**

Manea Senior College offers a modern, dynamic learning environment that delivers high quality education across a wide range of engaging and enriching courses. All Year 11 and 12 subjects, including Vocational Education & Training (VET) programs, attract compulsory charges. Payment of these charges is vital, as the College depends on them to ensure courses and programs are fully resourced and effectively delivered. We sincerely appreciate your support in making timely payments.

We recognise that the cost of schooling can place pressure on families, particularly at the start of the year. To assist, the College offers a range of payment options to help families meet their commitments. However, when a significant number of charges remain unpaid, the College is forced to adjust courses and programs to operate within a reduced budget. To support effective planning and resourcing, all charges are required to be **paid in full by the end of Term 1**, **2026.** If full payment is not possible, we ask that you enter into a Direct Debit Agreement with the College.

### **VET QUALIFICATIONS**

These courses are delivered by private RTOs (Registered Training Organisation) and have high costs associated with course delivery. If you are enrolled in a VET qualification as part of your full-time studies at Manea Senior College, Manea will subsidise course fees up to \$1,000 for all Year 11 students.

IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be a 50% deposit required to confirm enrolment in VET courses that are over \$1,000 per year and this DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED TO BE PAID TO THE COLLEGE BY THE 28 NOVEMBER 2025 with balance due by end of Term 1 2026.

Year 12 students are also eligible for this subsidy upon successful completion of Year 11 courses and full payment of any VET charges from Year 11. If there is a balance payable over and above the \$1,000 a separate communication will be sent to you for this amount. Students moving into Year 12 and undertaking a VET qualification, a 50% **DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED TO BE PAID TO THE COLLEGE BY THE 28 NOVEMBER 2025 with balance due by Term 1 2026.**

### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

**SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME:** To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a valid Centrelink card (Health Care/Pensioner Concession) or Veterans' Affairs card that has the students listed.

The Secondary Assistance Scheme consist of 2 components.

- \$115 Clothing Allowance paid directly to the parent/guardian or the College.
- \$235 Educational Program Allowance: paid directly to the College.

Applications for this scheme are completed through the College. The closing date to apply is the last day of Term 1, 2026. Parents must apply in person to the College and have their concession card with them. If students are in receipt of Abstudy they are not eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

**YOUTH ALLOWANCE**: A Youth Allowance is available for eligible students through Centrelink when they turn 16. Applicants are means tested and further information should be sought from Centrelink.

**ABSTUDY:** This grant is available to Aboriginal full-time students. Applications and enquiries should be made direct to Centrelink.

### **TYPE 1: ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE**

BYOD (bring your own device), calculator, stationery.

**Campion** is our preferred supplier for student stationery and textbooks. They offer a 20% discount on stationery and a 10% discount on textbooks via our Book/Resource List, with discounted prices already included. You may purchase from another supplier, but please ensure the correct copy/edition is selected and the student has all required items for their courses. As Bunbury has no back-to-school store, all orders are online and delivered to your home.

**NOTE:** The Charges & Contributions sheet will list the courses your child has been accepted into. You can use this sheet to match the relevant stationery and textbooks to determine what items are required.

### **TYPE 2: OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL**

**Uniform Concepts** (4/118 Spencer Street) is the sole supplier of the compulsory college student uniform and sports clothing. Uniform order sheet with prices is available on our website. Appointments can be made for fittings and extended operating hours occur over the January holidays.

### **COLLEGE BALL**

The College Ball is a Year 12 event. Outside partners may be considered through an approval process. The number of outside partners is also dependent on the number of tickets available to the event.

### LEAVER'S CEREMONY & AWARDS EVENING: \$20.00 – YEAR 12 STUDENTS ONLY

Year 12 students attending the official Leavers Ceremony & Awards Evening are required to wear a gown. This charge covers the hire of the gown and a sash with the year of graduation (student keeps the sash). This fee applies only to Year 12 students. Please note there is limited ticketing for this ceremony.

### YEARBOOK (Optional Cost): \$25.00

This Yearbook is a collection of photos, events, and stories from the past year at the College. Produced by our students and staff, it serves as a keepsake to look back on.

### PRINTING: \$20.00 / PHOTOCOPYING: \$20.00

At the start of each year, all students are credited with \$20 for printing computer-generated assignments and internet downloads and \$20 for general photocopying. If the credit is used before the end of the year, it can be topped up in \$5 increments at reception.

### **BREAKFAST CLUB: \$5:00**

Every morning, toast and a variety of toppings are available to all students until 10:00am. This initiative helps ensure that every student can start their day with breakfast and be ready to learn. To help cover the ongoing cost of supplies, we request a small contribution of \$5 per student/year. Your support will help us continue to offer this valuable service to all students.

### **SMART RIDER/STUDENT CARD: \$5.00**

Each student is issued with a Smart Rider Card with their photo (with parent permission). This card allows students to be eligible for concession travel on WA public buses and trains. The card can also be used as identification at the Movies etc for discount student entry rates.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Commencing 2026, students will also be required to use their Smart Rider Card to log in to photocopy machines.

### **COLLEGE PARKING**

With over 500 students and 75 staff and only 76 parking bays, we face significant challenges regarding parking. Therefore, student parking is only available as follows:

- 15 Parking Bays available in the YELLOW marked zone for **Year 12** students.
- Permit Application: Students can apply for a free parking permit, but availability exceeds spots, so it does not guarantee a space.
- Encourage car-pooling or alternative transport options are recommended.
- The City of Bunbury enforces parking rules. Fines for violations are issued, and all inquiries must go to them, not Manea.

### PAID PARKING - EDITH COWAN UNIVERSITY (ECU)

In 2026, Year 12 students can apply to purchase parking permits for ECU (Carpark 4) via an application process. There are limited spaces available (70) at a cost of approximately \$120 per year (full-time, part-time and half yearly rates are available). Please note that there will be no parking available at TAFE in 2026.
