Welcome to Manea Senior College. All Year 11 and 12 Subject and Vocational Education & Training (VET) costs are Charges and therefore **payment is compulsory**. The College relies very heavily on the payment of subject and VET charges to enable our courses/programs to be adequately funded. Your support with regards to prompt payment would be appreciated.

We understand the costs of schooling can be a burden for many families particularly at the beginning of each year. Therefore, we offer a range of payment strategies to assist families in meeting their commitments. The impact on the College of large numbers of parents not paying these charges is that we will be forced to adjust courses to fit within the constraints of a reduced budget.

To allow for planning/budgeting all Charges are to be fully paid by the end of Term 1 2024. If this is not possible, we request you enter into a Direct Debit Agreement with the College.

Payment Options Available

Online: Our Website has the option of paying online using your Card with BPoint. This is a fast and convenient way to make all payments to us and is our preferred method to receive payments.

EFTPOS: The College has EFTPOS facilities at reception.

Credit Card: Credit Card payments can be made either by phone or in person via the EFTPOS machine.

Direct Debit: Payments can be deducted from your bank account (cheque or savings) or your credit card on a weekly, fortnightly, or monthly plan. To arrange for College Charges to be debited from your bank account or credit card please contact the office.

BPAY: BPAY is a bill paying service that allows you to pay your bills over the telephone or internet banking online. Just look for the logo on your Account.

Financial Assistance

Secondary Assistance Scheme:

The Secondary Assistance Scheme is available to secondary students – compulsory and post-compulsory – whose parents hold a Centrelink Family Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card or Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Cards (blue card only).

The Secondary Assistance Scheme includes the Clothing Allowance and Educational Program Allowance.

If students are in receipt of Abstudy they are not eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

The Secondary Assistance Scheme is available to students up to and including the year in which they turn 18. Eligibility for the Secondary Assistance Scheme is based on a parent being the holder of a prescribed card. Students can only claim for themselves if they are classified by Centrelink as an Independent Youth. Appropriate evidence must be supplied by Centrelink to validate this claim.

Clothing Allowance: \$115.00 – Department of Education will forward a payment for \$115.00 to the bank account of claimants who have satisfied the eligibility criteria. Where parents wish to direct the Clothing Allowance to the College, they can indicate their intent on the application form.

Educational Program Allowance: \$235.00 – Department of Education will pay this amount direct to the college and it will be applied to the student charges.

Applications for this scheme are completed through the College. The closing date to apply is the last day of Term 1, 2024. Parents must apply in person to the College and have their concession card with them.

Youth Allowance

A Youth Allowance is available for eligible students through Centrelink when they turn 16. Applicants are means tested and further information should be sought from Centrelink.

Abstudy

This grant is available to Aboriginal full-time students. Applications and enquiries should be made direct to Centrelink.

VET Qualifications with Bunbury Regional Trade Training Centre (BRTTC) or other Registered Training Organisations (RTO's)

Training courses are generally categorised in two ways:

- Publicly Funded Courses - these are government funded courses which primarily occur through TAFE Colleges. Students who are successful in gaining entry to a TAFE course (with no course cost) are only able to access one funded course during their Year 11 and 12 education - TAFE ruling.
- Fee for Service Courses - these courses are generally run by private RTO's and have costs associated with course delivery. Courses run by the BRTTC and private RTOs fall into this category.

If you have been accepted into a Vocational Training course at BRTTC or another RTO as part of your full-time enrolment with Manea Senior College, and there are course enrolment charges associated with the qualification, Manea will subsidise these costs for you up to the amount of \$1,000 for all Year 11 students. Year 12 students are also eligible for this subsidy upon successful completion of Year 11 courses and full payment of any VET charges from Year 11. If there is a balance payable over and above the \$1,000 a separate communication will be sent to you for this amount. There will be a 50% deposit required to confirm enrolment in the courses that are over \$1,000 per year and this deposit is required to be paid to the College by the 7 December 2023.

*** For students moving into Year 12 who are undertaking a fee for service VET qualification, a 50% deposit is also required before a VET course can be confirmed and the student enrolled.*

With some VET courses there may be additional costs for text books, personal protective equipment and/or specific course equipment. You will be advised of these additional costs from the institution delivering the course.

SIDE (School Isolated Distance Education) Course Costs - \$50 (Approx.)

This course cost is set by SIDE.

After Hours Classes (with partner schools)

Course costs for after-hours classes managed by other schools will be determined by the host school.

Student Uniforms - Compulsory

Stationery & Text Requirements

Campion is our preferred supplier for all student stationery requirements and textbooks. In lieu of a rebate to the College, Campion provide a 20% discount for Stationery and a 10% discount for Texts if sold through our Book/Resource List. The discount price has already been built into the price on our lists. Parents/caregivers can purchase from another supplier. If you are purchasing textbooks from someone other than our preferred supplier, please take care to ensure you are getting the correct copy/edition for the course. Please ensure the student has all the necessary items required for the courses they are enrolled in. **As there is no store in Bunbury offering a back-to-school service ordering will be on-line. Packs are delivered to your home address.**

Note: *Your Charges & Contributions Sheet will have the courses that your son/daughter has been accepted into. From this Sheet you can then match with your Stationery & Text Requirements to work out exactly what you require.*

General Stationery: *It is expected that students will arrive at every class with basic stationery items such as pens/pencils, paper/file, notebook, ruler, eraser, glue etc.*

Manea Senior College may during 2024 offer some optional activities that will have a high cost associated with their provision. Participation in these events is voluntary, but a charge is payable if your son/daughter opts to participate. The amounts listed below are the maximum costs. Parking

Manea Senior College – onsite parking

With over 500 students, 75 staff and only 76 parking bays available onsite, doing the math clearly shows the challenge we have in relation to parking. Given this situation, parking for students is extremely limited across the precinct and cannot be guaranteed.

In 2024 there are 15 bays at Manea for Year 12 students (in the YELLOW marked zone). Students in Year 12 can submit an application for a parking permit to the College which will then be reviewed. Parking permits will be issued in due course at no cost; however, this does not guarantee a parking spot as more permits will be issued than spaces available. Hence car-pooling and other means of travel to the College should be strongly considered by students.

It should also be noted that parking is monitored across the precinct (Manea/TAFE and ECU) and fines are issued for illegal parking (wrong area, no permit etc.). The City of Bunbury monitors Manea and TAFE parking with all fines and infringements collected by them. Where an infringement is issued, all correspondence must go through the City of Bunbury for resolution, not Manea Senior College.

Paid Parking – Edith Cowan University (ECU)

In 2024 the option of purchasing permits to park at ECU (Carpark 4) is available for Year 12 students – an application process applies. Limited spaces at ECU are available (70) at a cost of approximately \$98 per year.

Please note there is no parking at TAFE for 2024

Voluntary Approved Requests

Printing: \$20.00

All students at the beginning of each year will be credited with \$20.00 to allow them to print computer generated assignments and internet downloads. Printing at the College is charged at 0.02 cents per A4 copy (B & W) 0.08 cents per A4 copy (Colour). If the \$20.00 is used prior to the end of the year, the balance can be topped up in \$5 increments through Reception.

Photocopying: \$15.00

This charge is to cover general limited photocopying done by students throughout the year.

Smart Rider/Student Card: \$5.00

Each student is issued with a Smart Rider Card with their photo (with parent permission). This card allows students to be eligible for concession travel on WA public buses and trains. The card can also be used as identification at the Movies etc for discount student entry rates.

Leaver's Ceremony & Awards Evening: \$10.00 – Year 12 Students Only

Year 12 leaving students are required to wear a Gown if they are attending the official Leavers Ceremony & Awards Evening. This charge is for the hire of the Gown and a Sash with the year of finishing school that the student will keep. The charge also covers a contribution towards event costs and limited tickets to the Ceremony. This charge is only payable by Year 12 students.

Student Central: \$10.00

This request is put towards materials, resources, games, and magazines for inclusion in the Resource Centre for use by the students.

Yearbook (Optional Cost): \$25.00

This book is a compilation of photos, events and stories that have happened at the College over the year. It is produced by our students and staff as a keepsake to look back on.

Manea Cafe

The College Cafe is open every day during school terms from 8.00am to 3.15pm whilst students are on site. Lunch orders are to be completed by 9.30am each day. Our Cafe adopts the Healthy Food & Drink Guidelines and offers a variety of nutritious selections daily. Cool drink, lollies, chocolate, and fried foods are prohibited from sale. The Cafe offers EFTPOS facilities (no cash out option).
